Voice of the Children Orphanage

This is a little orphanage we found in the heart of Port au Prince. It is ran by a widow of a pastor who has a heart for children. This orphanage of 43 children and 5 workers was within weeks of being dissolved. They had no food, water and barely any shelter. We believe God put our paths together. HH4H has partnered with VOC Orphanage since 2013.

With the help of sponsors we have provided food, safe shelter, and every child goes to school.

Rice and beans is a common meal throughout the world, and is a staple in Haiti. We are continually monitoring the diet of the children to add variety and other forms of nutrition with quality protein and vegetables.



SCHOOL-

Education is not free in Haiti, therefore your gift provides all the necessary tuition, uniforms and books. Keep in mind that the average cost of children above 6th grade is often more than double of a younger child. It is not uncommon for a Haitian to be limited to a 6th grade education, if any.

As you can imagine the day-to-day expense of caring for 43 children is significant. Things we take for granted, such as water and electricity are not always accessible. Water and cooking fuel must be purchased. Other expenses include Haitian staff and occasional medical expenses for the children. These are items that must be budgeted, but cannot be predicted.
